Course selection information

General instructions

- ▶ Using the UNSW Handbook, faculty websites, and timetables, list the courses you intend to enrol in during your study period at UNSW.
- ▶ Be aware that future timetables are not always available and so you may have to use current timetables as an indication of the likely future availability of a course in a particular session. If in doubt, enquire with the faculty responsible for the course.
- ▶The UNSW Handbook and timetables can be found at the following addresses: www.handbook.unsw.edu.au www.timetable.unsw.edu.au
- ▶ Visa regulations state that you must be enrolled full-time to remain in Australia, and UNSW requires a full-time study load over your stay.
- ▶The normal full-time load at UNSW is between 12 and 18 UoC per term. For short terms, the study load is 6 UoC.
- ▶ Most courses will be worth 6 units of credit each, and so a normal full-time study load equates to 2 or 3 courses worth 6 UoC each.
- ▶ You may choose ONLY courses for which you satisfy the prior knowledge requirements (prerequisites).
- ▶Your academic transcript must show courses that satisfy the UNSW course prerequisites.
- ▶ This information will be sent to faculties for assessment and approval.

Rounds

- ► There are three rounds for course requests:
- ▶ Round 1 (initial request): If you are applying for more than 1 session, this will be at least for the first session. Course requests for subsequent sessions will become available after your initial request, but you may be able to make such request at the point of application, depending on timetables.
- ▶ Round 2 (additional requests): After you submit your initial requests, your course requests are reviewed by course authorities. You will be able to request new courses for approval to substitute any declined courses. You may do this multiple times.
- ▶ Round 3 (enrolment variation): Upon arrival at UNSW, you should have a complete enrolment set, but you will be given further opportunities to request changes before you start study.

Enrolment

- ▶ Enrolment will depend upon class availability and timetable clashes.
- ▶ While we will endeavour to enrol you in your preferred courses, this cannot always be guaranteed.
- ▶ Enrolment is subject to faculty approval so you need to be flexible with your course choices.
- ▶If you still have insufficient courses to fill your minimum requirement, we will allow you to make changes to your courses to add new courses.
- ▶ You will be contacted if there are any major problems with your proposed enrolment otherwise you are able to change your enrolment after you arrive at UNSW. You have until the first week of each term to do this.

Multi-term study

- ▶ Students coming on multi-term study will be pre-enrolled for at least their commencement term of study.
- ▶ You are not required to enter courses for your subsquent sessions until the previous session has begun, but you may do so in advance if you want early approval. Note that timetables might not be available, which may delay any early approval.

Excluded courses

- ▶ While most faculties and disciplines will accept suitably qualified students, the following are NOT open to Exchange/Study Abroad students:
- ▶The Australian Graduate School of Management (AGSM) operates its own exchange program and will not accept additional students into its MBA programs.
- ▶ The Faculty of Medicine generally does not accept students through the Exchange/Study Abroad program except through special exchange arrangements. Students however can generally enrol in courses from the School of Medical Science.
- ▶The Australian Defence Force Academy in Canberra will NOT accept Exchange/Study Abroad students into its programs: ie any course starting with code prefix ZBUS, ZEIT, ZGEN, ZHSS, ZINT, or ZPEM.
- ▶ Any course starting with code prefix MDIA is restricted to special agreements (ask your international study office).
- ▶ Any course starting with code prefix MDCM (students should choose MEFT courses instead).
- ▶There is a limit on web-based courses. Enquire with us if you plan to do more than 1 web-based course.
